Dear Parents,

I have enjoyed a frantic, frustrating, fulfilling and fun year. As a team we have never worked so hard or worried so much but we have made it and stayed open. Congratulations to the whole Broughton Team and all the mums, dads, carers and grandparents who have so generously supported the school. Summer holidays here we come!

**What will school look like in September? (If there is not another closure!)**

The government has lifted all restrictions on schools. We will be returning to our normal school processes,

- Class bubbles will cease and children will mix freely inside the classroom and outside,
- Class bubbles will not be sent home if one child tests positive,
- Masks will be a personal choice,
- Parents will have the opportunity to talk to staff at the end of the day,
- Parents will be invited to school events such as Class Assemblies, Parents' Evenings, Christmas Plays, Sports Day and Gala,
- Clubs such as Gymnastics, Basketball, Football, Choir and Recorder will re-start,
- Children will bring home reading books and can bring in pencil cases if they wish.

**What will stay the same?**

- Drop off at the school entrance on Cransley Hill,
- Pick up from the playground – email [office@my-bps.co.uk](mailto:office@my-bps.co.uk) if your child becomes a 'walk-off',
- Named water bottle,
- Trainers and Winter PE kit - Plimsolls and summer PE kit,
- A small bag - please no massive rucksacks!
- Before and After School club.
- We will continue with hand sanitiser and hand washing routines.

**This is of course dependent on government advice - we could go back a step if we are instructed to by government.**

**Drop and Go in the mornings- 8:45.**

There is always something good that comes out of difficult times. Children have now learnt how to come into school independently and this has been good for their confidence and self-esteem. We have found that lessons now start promptly which is popular with teachers. For parents it means a speedy get away and more availability of parking on Cransley Hill.

So from September we will be keeping 'Drop and Go' in the mornings. Staff will be on the pathway to welcome children in and to walk them to the classroom. Any quick messages can be passed along.
