Working circumstances changed since Covid

Have your working circumstances changed over the last year? If so and you are in receipt of the below you will be entitled to free school meals, help with uniform and school trips. Please see the link below or call Mrs Marlow, our Business Manager, she will be able to talk you through this and help you.

- Universal Credit (annual net income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
- Income Support, income-based Jobseeker's Allowance or income-based Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying)
