Applying for a Primary School Place for September 2021

The easiest and quickest way to apply is online at www.northamptonshire.gov.uk/admissions. The application process opened on 10th September 2020 and you will need to register using an email address. You may also download a copy of the 'Applying for a Primary School Place in Northamptonshire 2021/22' prospectus from our website and you are advised to read this carefully before making your application.

Closing date for applications

Your application form must reach us by 5 p.m. on **15th January 2021**. Failure to do this may affect your chances of obtaining a place for your child at your preferred schools.

Broughton Primary School- will my child get a place?

We have 30 school places for admission into Broughton Primary in Reception Class. Your chances of getting a place are decided by the following:

1. Looked After Children
2. Children who are resident in Broughton or Cransley
3. Siblings of children attending Broughton Primary
4. Distance from the school

Will Broughton Primary be oversubscribed?

The school is sometimes oversubscribed - this is down to birth rates which vary year to year.

For children who live in the village or have a sibling in the school it is very likely that you will gain a school place. For families who live out of the village or do not have siblings it is decided on distance so not easy to predict.

Open Days

At this time of year I am usually welcoming children and parents into the school for tours of the school. We obviously cannot do this at the moment. For those parents who are new to the school I am offering a zoom meeting. This is not suitable for families with siblings as you know the school already. We may be able to offer tours at a later date.

If you have a younger child due to start school in September 2021 it would be good to hear from you. Once you have made your choice please send me an email and let me know a little about your child. If you have any questions or concerns you can request a phone call with me. I look forward to welcoming your child into the Broughton family.
