Option 2: 2 tickets for the evening performance

Option 3 1 ticket for the morning performance and 1 ticket for the evening performance

A waiting list will operate for extra tickets, please email bursar@broughtonprimary.northants-ecl.gov.uk to apply. These will be issued on a 'first come-first served' basis from the 2nd December. For Fire Safety reasons every person who attends must have a ticket. If you accidentally book more than 2 tickets, we will delete the extra tickets and allocate the first ones booked.

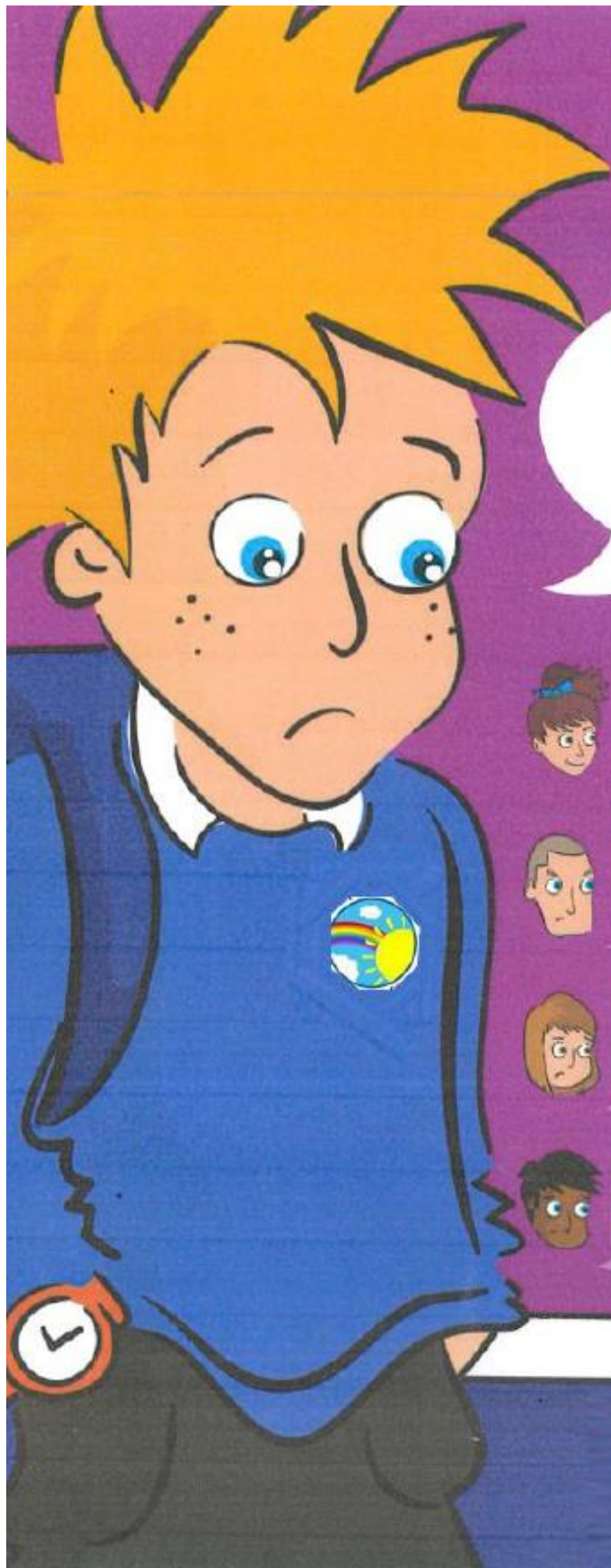
