CHANGE OF TIME TO SCHOOL DAY

Rolling admission has been working well.

8:45-9:00- 'Rolling' admission for all children- from Cransley Hill.

All children must be in school by 9:00. After this they will be marked as late.

3:10- school closes KS1

Dismissal from playground in the one way system. Siblings dismissed together.

3:20- Key Stage 2- Children with permission to walk of site will be dismissed first

All other children dismissal from the playground on the one way system.

Do not come into school until 3:20 to allow us time to dismiss younger children.

All Siblings will be dismissed with the youngest child.

Dark nights-One way system

As the night get dark it will be safer to dismiss the children from the playground. The One Way system will operate in the afternoon.

1. The electric gates for cars will open,
2. Parents walk up the driveway, collect child from playground gate
3. Walk down the pedestrian path with your child to go home.
