Christmas Concert Places

A reminder that there are still some tickets available on ParentPay. Places are £1 and proceeds will go to Kettering Food Bank, as this charity directly benefits Broughton families.

You may find the information below helpful when booking a performance:

- Places are limited, this is because the capacity of the school hall is limited due to Fire Safety regulations,
- If you have child/ren in KS1 you may only buy 2 places, this can be 1 place for each performance or 2 places for 1 performance.
- If you have a child/ren in KS2 you may only buy 2 places, this can be 1 place for each performance or 2 places for 1 performance.
- If you buy too many places, we will not give a refund. We will call to see which performance you would like to attend.
- Places are booked through your child's online ParentPay account only, no cash purchases.

- A member of staff is on the door with a list of who has made a booking, so there is no need for a physical ticket.
- Everyone who attends must have a booked place, this is for fire safety. Additional adults and children without bookings **will not** be admitted. Please do not come to the school without a booking.
- Babies / pre-school children will not be admitted.
- A waiting list for spare places is in operation, if you would like to go on the list, please email bursar@broughtonprimary.northants-ecl.gov.uk This will be on a first come first served basis. Places will be allocated week commencing 4th December.
