Holidays in Term time - Increase in fines to £80 from September

Headteachers do not have the authority to grant holidays in term time. If you choose to take your child out of school you need to fill out the 'Leave of Absence' form so that we know why your child is absent from school. It is vital that this form is completed before departure or staff may be concerned about an extended absence and do a home visit to ensure your child is safe. Absence reported as sickness immediately prior to or after holiday in term-time will be considered part of the holiday and unauthorised.

- There is no need to book a place, parents and grandparents are welcome

- Assemblies last 15-20 minutes and start at 9.10
