2 pair of old trainers	For outdoors and for water activities – no flip flops or slippers. 1 pair will get very wet.	
A warm hat and gloves	Wool or fleece – even in summer	
2 large towels	1 for showers, 1 for changing after activities	
2 large bin liners	For wet clothes after activities	
Wash bag - toothbrush, toothpaste, face cloth, hairbrush, roll on deodorant, etc.	No sprays please.	
Night clothes / pyjamas		
1 or 2 named plastic drinks bottles		
£5 maximum spending money in a named envelope or purse (child is responsible for)	There is a small souvenir shop at Longtown.
