Warm weather – sun safety

- Sun cream should ideally be applied by parents before school, adults in school are not permitted to apply cream,
- You may send in sun cream (please name), roll-ons maybe easier to apply and children must be able to do this themselves,
- Water bottles should contain water.

Your help please

We strive to keep the children and visitors to the site safe. For this reason we have the following rules and we ask for your help in ensuring a safe site at busy time such as dismissal, Sports Day and Gala.

- Scooters or bikes must not be ridden on the school paths or playground. Collisions have happened and babies and older visitors knocked over. The children know this rule and we are asking that you remind them and be considerate of others.
- To prevent falls and accidents - The trim trail must be supervised by a member of Broughton staff - younger children, visiting teenagers or pupils should not play on it after school or during events. Please help us by keeping this rule.
- Bikes and toys outside Year R - The use of these bikes and toys must be supervised by a member of staff. Please do not allow pre-school children to take them out.
