- ✓ There will be FOBS refreshments, tombola, books, pre-loved uniform etc. afterwards – please bring small change!
- ✓ Parking can become difficult, so please consider walking or parking and striding,
- ✓ This is an outdoor event and is weather dependent- if cancelled a text will be sent.

Warm weather – Sun safety
