Dear Parents,

We appreciate that the end-of-day pick-up period can be a very busy time, and we understand that this can sometimes be frustrating. Our priority, however, is to ensure that every child is dismissed safely and securely.

To help us make the end-of-day dismissal as smooth and safe as possible, we kindly ask that you follow the guidelines below:

- **Collection arrangements:** Please ensure that the school office is kept up to date with anyone who has permission to collect your child. We kindly ask for your patience while staff check collection arrangements.
- **Dismissal of children first:** Please allow teachers to safely dismiss all children before approaching them for a conversation. Teachers will be very happy to speak with you once dismissal is complete.
- **Re-entry:** To help us avoid confusion and ensure no child is accidentally overlooked, please wait until all children have been safely dismissed before asking your child to return inside the classroom if they have left an item behind.
- **Lost property:** Children do, from time to time, misplace belongings. Please check our lost property, which is located in the after-school club. Labelling your child's belongings clearly helps us return lost items more quickly.
- **Waiting outside the classroom:** For the safety and security of all children, please wait outside the classroom until every child has been safely dismissed. Once dismissal is complete, the class teacher will invite you into the classroom if a meeting is needed.

We are always happy to speak with you and appreciate that there may be times when you need to discuss something with your child's teacher. If we are unable to speak at the end of the day, please feel free to contact us by email. Staff email addresses are available on the school website.

Thank you for your continued patience, understanding and cooperation. Your support helps us ensure that the end of each school day is calm, safe and positive for everyone.

Thank you for helping us to keep all of our children safe.
